INTERVENTION AREA 1. LOCAL PUBLIC SERVICES

Progress Review

This chapter concerns the progress made on achieving the different Results of the **Intervention Area 1. Local Public Services** following the indicators of the project and monitoring the achievement of planned milestones. These are elaborated based on the assumption that the planned activities will lead to achieving progress in reaching the IA1 Specific Objective: *"The Local Public Authorities effectively cooperate and manage the improvements of local public services in the selected communities in pilot Rayons".*

Information here relates to the timeframe 1 January, 2014 to 31 May, 2014 and to all the milestones in the 3 sectors: Water Supply and Sanitation (WSS), Solid Waste Management (SWM) and Energy Efficiency (EE), mostly targeted to the selected communities of the following pilot rayons:

Improving Water Supply and Sanitation in communities from Cahul, Riscani and Leova Rayons.

Improvement of Solid Waste Management Services in Soldanesti, Rezina and Floresti Rayons.

Improvement of Energy Efficiency in street lighting and on public buildings in Soroca, Orhei and Nisporeni Rayons.

The progress in reaching this Specific Objective is measured using the main Success Indicators presented below:

Success Indicators for IA1:

Indicator 1: 25 planned pilot measures for the improvement of local public services are being implemented in the three project priority sectors WSS, SWM and EE. (Baseline: 2010: 0; Verification source: Implemented financing agreements).

Indicator 2: Local public authorities signed 70 F formal agreements for the joint delivery of local public services in the three project priority sectors (Baseline: 2010: 0; Verification source: Cooperation agreements.)

Indicator 3: In 35 communities, 50% of implemented measures in the three project priority sectors have improved access of women to local public services. (Baseline: 2010: 0; Verification source: Representative survey in 10 communities.)

During the process of achieving the milestones MLPS project takes the opportunity to share the experience and lessons learned. The activities planned and conducted, as well as the set milestones were designed in a gender-responsive manner and prepared documents are gender mainstreamed.

All pilot projects benefit from a five-dimensional support structure where each dimension connects to specific results overall leading to effective and efficient local public services provision. (*Figure 1*)

INTERVENTION AREA 2. REGIONAL PLANNING AND PROGRAMMING

PROGRESS REVIEW

This chapter presents the progress on achievements reached during the period 1 January – 31 May, 2014 on Results/milestones, according to the GIZ Results based M&E System related to the Intervention Area 2 (IA2): Regional Planning and Programming. These are elaborated based on the assumption that the planned activities will lead to achieving progress in reaching the IA2 Specific Objective: "Regional and Local Public Authorities effectively plan strategic investments in the three priority sectors (water and sanitation, solid waste management and energy efficiency of public buildings)".

The progress in reaching this Specific Objective is measured using the main Success Indicators presented below:

Success Indicators for IA2:

Indicator 1: The three Regional Development Agencies have facilitated the development of viable project concepts in the priority sectors with a total value of €170m (Baseline: 2010 - 0; Verification source: Project concept documents presented.)

Indicator 2: 70% of stakeholders from 30 Local Public Authorities involved into local planning and programming express their satisfaction with the facilitation capacities of Regional Development Agencies (Baseline: 2012 - 34%; Verification source:

Survey carried out by the Congress of Local Authorities from Moldova in 2012 and 2014)

Indicator 3: 75% of project concepts facilitated by Regional Development Agencies are scrutinised in terms of environmental impact considering national regulations. (Baseline: 2010: 0; Verification source: Project concept documents, GOPA assessment grid.)

The progress in achieving the IA2 specific objective, results and milestones is planned through the implementation of a core stream of activities related to the regional planning and programming in 3 regions (North, South and Centre) in 5 sectors (Water Supply and Sanitation (WSS), Energy Efficiency of Public Buildings and street lighting (EE), Solid Waste Management (SWM), Regional and Local Roads (RLR) and Complementary Private Sector Support (CPSS). Additionally, progress on achieving the milestones on some cross-cutting activities in relation to Results-based Monitoring and Evaluation (RBM), Communications on Regional Development, Cross-Border Cooperation, and support to Academy of Public Administration is presented.

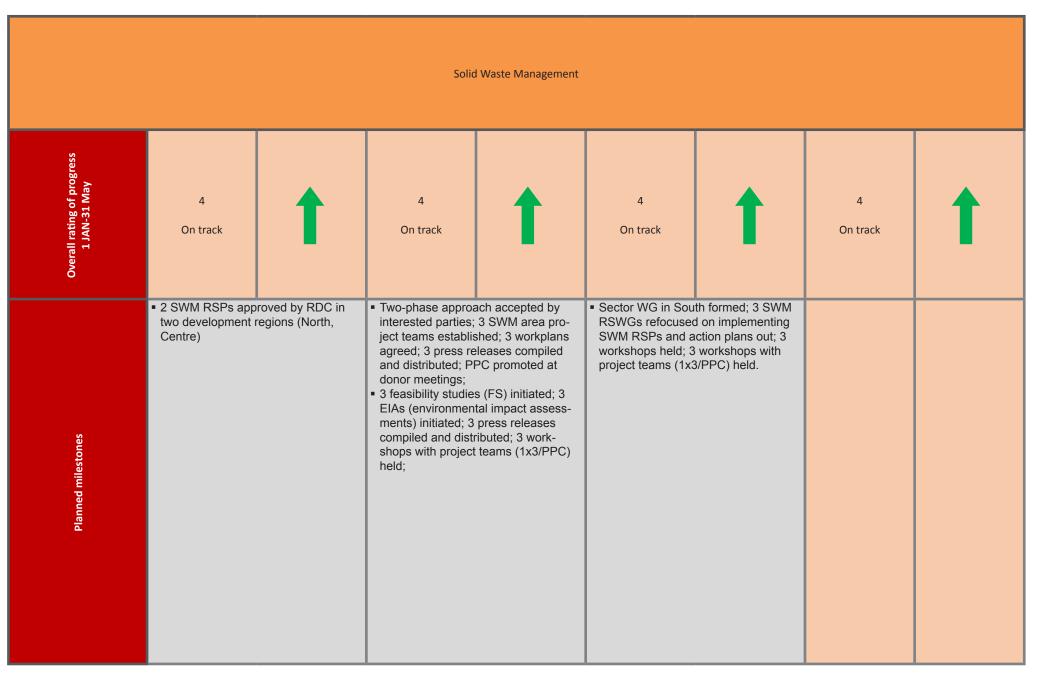

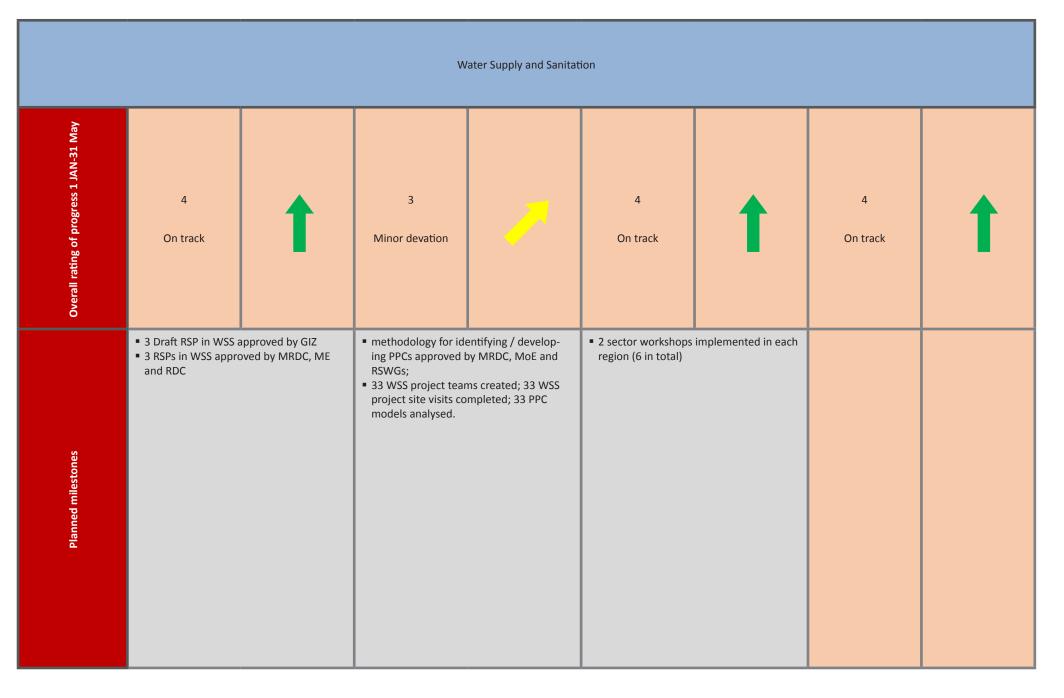

During five months, GIZ assisted the Academy of Public Administration of the Republic of Moldova (APA) in organising two training programs on local and regional planning and programming offered to LPAs I and LPAs II. The training program was comprised of two modules:

- Management and strategic planning;
 Management and programs /
- projects development.

'During these training programs, 99 representatives of LPAs level I and II from the three regions of Moldova, including Chisinau, participated in the training programs. Of them 29 % from the northern region, 21% from southern region and 50% from centre region. 55% female and 45% were male.

Also, in this period APA delivered three training courses on "Regional Development" offered to LPAs I and II. During these training programs, 65 representatives of level I and II LPAs from the three regions of Moldova, including Chisinau, participated in the training programs. Of them 26 % from the northern region, 22% from southern region and 52% from centre region. 48% female and 52% were male.

The European Commission and the European External Action Service have already officially launch the ENI CBC 2014-2020 programming exercise, inviting the Programmes stakeholders to launch the programming process. In the case of future CBC ENI Programmes, implemented through shared management with a Member State, the Partner Country (Republic of Moldova) has to set up a reliable counterpart system that will support the Managing Authority in the implementation of the Programme on its territory. In this context, the Republic of Moldova is facing the need to adjust the existing national institutional and legal provisions, which at the present moment do not sufficiently respond to the requirements. In the reporting period, GIZ assisted the State Chancellery of the Republic of Moldova, as National Authority for CBC Programmes, in following activities:

- to organize two workshops (16.04.2014 and 20.05.2014) for the national working group on programming for the ENI CBC Programmes 2014-2020 in order to strengthening the capacities and set up the shared management system.
- to develop a concept of the national system in the Republic of Moldova for implementation of the shared management principle.

- March 11, 2014 press-club in Cimislia, Development Region South
- March 28, 2014 workshop organized for the communications specialists of MRDC and the RDAs to discuss the draft recommendations
- March 31, 2014 the monitoring report was finalized and sent to partners

The local subsidy for Independent Press Association was extended till April 30, 2014.

With reference to SIGEDIA. the minor deviation occurred because of the changes related to SIGEDIA for the 8 ministries and the State Chancellery, which involve the ELO standard for its clients: ELO web client and ELO Java client etc. in order to increase functionality, being also more user-friendly. This solution seems to be more durable, specific personalization in the code being not necessary. The company who designs the MIS submitted an action plan, which was accepted by MRDC on February 3, 2014.

Within the intervention area II, eight students from Academy of Public Administration of the Republic of Moldova (APA) had the possibility of enhancing their knowledge and practical skills in regional development planning and programming under the sector workshops which served as a forum for them. Throughout the period February 2013 – April 2014, eight students participated in the regional sector planning workshops which cover three sectors and three regions (Energy Efficiency – five students; Solid Waste Management three students; Water Supply and Sanitation - four students). Based on the experience gained, they have prepared their master theses in regional development policy area. Among the chosen themes are: "Tools for improving the local public sector efficiency", "Regional development policy in Moldova - a premise for the implementation and development of water supply and sewerage sector", "Integrated strategic planning in the context of the modernisation local public services", "The contribution of the development crossborder cooperation projects of the northern region", etc. In the period 2-6.06.2014, students have defended of their master theses.

- to draft a methodological guideline on recovery procedure based on the existing legal procedure.

After the discussions with the experts, it was recommended to postpone carrying out the study on the impact of CBC programmes 2007-2013 on regional development areas.
